PBYC House Rules

The management of Pensacola Beach Yacht Club, its affairs, assets and property is vested in the Board of Directors (BOD). The BOD has adopted the following rules and regulations for: 1) the conduct of the operations and affairs of the club; 2) for the protection of its status as a private club; and 3) for the protection of its property. Conduct that is observed or displayed in the club or on club property that is unbecoming or in violation of these rules and regulations may result in action by the BOD to include removal from the premises and/or loss of privileges.

- 1. Members bringing guests to the club shall sign them in the guest book and sign as the sponsoring member. Guests frequenting the Club more than once a month are encouraged to pursue Club membership. Since PBYC is a private club, no unaccompanied guest(s) of a member may avail themselves of any of the facilities of the club at any time.
- 2. Members shall not bring an excessive number of guests to a single function or abuse the frequency of guest visits to the club.
- 3. Members may be asked to show their membership card at the bar to verify their good standing status. A paper copy of your membership card can be found by logging into your membership account on the website
- 4. Only members in good standing may run a bar tab. These tabs are expected to be paid "same day". Noncompliance with the policy may result in loss of bar tab privileges.
- 5. Guest privileges are extended to persons bearing GYA affiliated yacht club membership cards for those clubs located outside of a 100 miles radius of the club. Under certain conditions, other guests, such as registered participants in a scheduled regatta or event will be required to sign in upon entry to the club.
- 6. Previous Club Members expelled or otherwise terminated by the Club may not return to PBYC as a guest of PBYC member and do not qualify for reciprocity privileges from other yacht clubs. Expelled or terminated members may attend non-Club events on PBYC property unless specifically barred by the Board of Directors.
- 7. Shoes and shirts must be worn in the club.
- 8. No smoking is allowed in the club.
- 9. No discussions involving religion or politics may take place on club property.
- 10. Only authorized persons are permitted behind the bar or in the club office.
- 11. Members are responsible for the behavior and any damages resulting from the activities of their associate members, dependents, significant others, and guests.

The following rules are presented with regards to STATE LAWS:

- 1. Alcoholic beverages shall not be sold to anyone under the State of Florida's legal drinking age.
- 2. Alcoholic beverages purchased elsewhere may not be brought into the club or outside deck.
- 3. Alcoholic beverages may only be served to members in good standing and their guests.
- 4. Alcoholic beverages purchased at the club may not be taken from the licensed area (the interior of the club and the deck area immediately in front.
- 5. Minors are not permitted to sit at the bar while alcoholic beverages are being sold.
- 6. No pets, except service dogs, are allowed in the club or deck area.
