Dear Ocean Cruisers:

I'd like to get a sense of your interest in joining a Rally or Destination Cruise to the Bahamas in January 2024. I am on the Board of Seven Seas Cruising Association (<u>www.ssca.org</u>) and we are looking at organizing a very informal Rally/Destination Cruise, potentially with two legs: Gulf Coast and East Coast, that would essentially merge in the Bahamas in early Spring 2024. We currently have a "Bahamas Gathering" planned for March in Black Point Exumas, which we have done for the past 2 years and had about 65 boats in attendance each year. Lorraine's Café hosts the event and puts on several parties, Beach BBQs, entertainment etc. over a 3-day weekend. We are also looking at other potential stops along the way and possibly a leg to the Ragged Islands. We would also potentially include some of the other Bahamas Regattas that occur during that period.

The Rally would be very informal with only limited organization. The idea is to simply promote sailing camaraderie. Boats would have the option to join for specific legs or multiple legs and

timing would be flexible depending upon weather etc. Any costs would be minimal and only charged to cover rally-specific activities. We will also seek out discounts at stops along the way.

I have talked to several of you already, and we have a small group already planning to head to the Bahamas from Pensacola, but I think it would be fun to expand this. So please let me know if you are potentially interested, and feel free to share this info with others.
