In Class A, congrats to Paul and Rachael Gillette and Papa John and Scotty Mathis for their 2nd and 3rd places, and in Class B Lil' Shady and the Dunbar crew ran away with a bullet, Kirk Newkirk and his motley crew had a 2nd, and Ken Loftin and Jeff and Ellen Hunt gave everyone a run for the money. This past month, PBYC sailors along with PYC, Navy Yacht Club, and 5 other clubs from the Gulf Yachting Association competed in the 24<sup>th</sup> annual GYA Fish Class Championship for the John G. Curren Cup at Buccaneer YC on Mobile Bay. Congratulations to Navy Yacht club for taking 1<sup>st</sup> place overall again this year; that makes 3 years in a row!

The Fish Class was the Gulf Yachting Association's first adopted boat that permitted GYA clubs to compete against each other in the early 1900s. A few Pensacola Bay area sailors purchased boats that were languishing in disrepair in the Mobile Bay area and brought them back into racing condition during the Covid Pandemic. Each year, the John Curren Cup commemorates the Fish Class's early roots of GYA interclub competition. Pensacola Yacht Club and Buccaneer YC alternate years for this event. This fish boat regatta is a unique way of racing the legendary Fish

boats. The clubs that qualified to race this year were PBYC, PYC, Navy, Bay Waveland, Mobile, Point, Buccaneer, Fairhope and Southern.

This is a 'round-robin' event where boats are exchanged between the competitors after each race and the selection lottery process is structured to be as equitable as possible. The regatta was well attended by racers and spectators alike. And a big shout-out to DJ for loaning his power boat as a support vessel for PBYC; this gave us the ability to host the John Curren family on Sunday to watch the racing on the water. This finished out a great year of racing for PBYC sailors. I urge all members of PBYC to come out next year and watch this type of regatta when it is held here on Pensacola Bay. PBYC's team consisted of Charley Harp, Darrell Via, Tom Schlosser, Jeff Zern, Scott Hand, Carol Anne Mackey, Kelli Taylor and myself. PBYC's best race was a second with Jeff Zern on the helm and Darrell Via and Tom Schlosser as crew.
